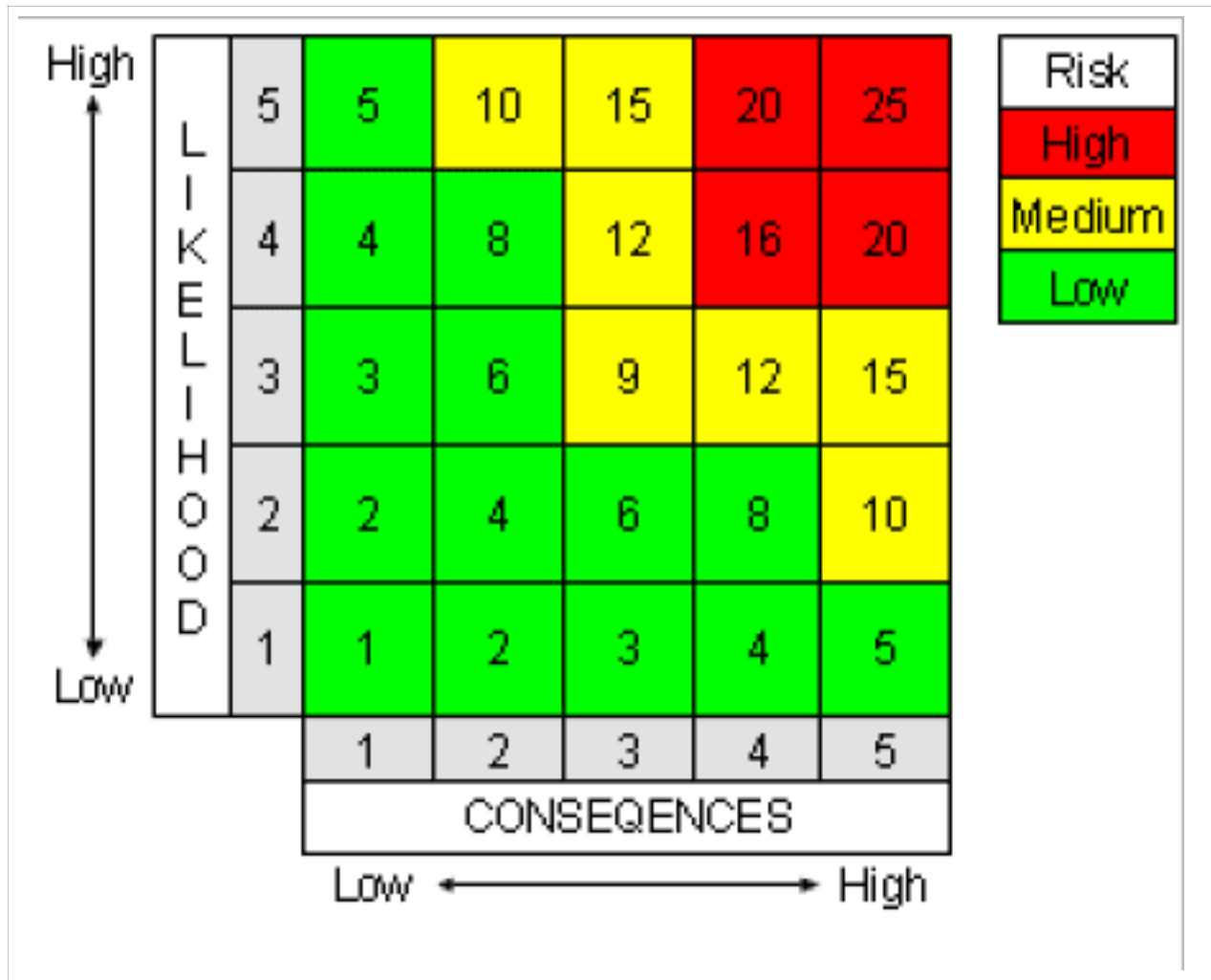

	Boss Stands	Splinters, Strains	None	3	2	Low	Do not lift if units too heavy or seek assistance. Wear gloves provided.
	Moving Bosses	Strains, Collision	Fixed Handles Provided Castor wheels on one end	2	2	Low	Ensuring clear access when descending the slope. Do not rush
Setting out range	Heavy Equipment.	Strains	Experience / Awareness Lifting Bosses is 2 man job	2	2	Low	Inform new archers of safe operating methods
	Wooden frames with Moving Parts	Trapped fingers. Foreign Body Cuts / Bruises	Personal Awareness Targets and safety margins in accordance with Archery GB Range Rules Experience of Archers	1	2	Low	Regular Equipment Checks & Provide Gloves
	3rd Party Ingress	Body Penetration	Emergency Exit Door is closed for duration. Access only into waiting area once shooting in progress	1	5	Low	Consider provision of signs on outside of E.Exit Doors
Setting up of Bows	Bows in tension.	Knocks to hands and face,	All Archers instructed in correct method of bow assembly.	2	2	Low	No further action
	Arrows	Stabs	Arrows are contained until shoot signal is made				
Shooting	Loosed Arrows	Body Penetration	All Archers trained in safe handling of bow and follow "Shoot" and "Clear" sound signals. No Archer is forward of shoot line during shooting. All Archers vigilant of public and know to call FAST / 4 whistles.	1	5	Low	No further action
	Overshot Arrows	Building Damage	Safety Net suspended behind targets	2	2	Low	No further action
